Алгоритм виконання річної контрольної роботи 9 клас (екстернат)

Річна контрольна робота складається з трьох завдань: читання, аудіювання та граматичного тесту.

Рекомендації до виконання завдання «Читання»:

1. Ознайомтесь з повним текстом та окремими заголовками.
2. Прочитайте окремі абзаци, визначте головний зміст кожного абзацу.
3. Підберіть найкращий варіант заголовку.
4. Ще раз прочитайте текст та перевірте себе.

Рекомендації до виконання завдання «Аудіювання»:

1. Перед прослуховуванням ознайомтесь із заданням.
2. Визначте тему та пригадайте лексику за цією темою.
3. Прослухайте аудіо перший раз та позначте варіанти відповідей.
4. Прослухайте аудіо вдруге та перевірте себе.

Рекомендації до виконання завдання «Аудіювання»:

1. Ознайомтесь із завданням.
2. Поступово читаючи речення, визначте його часову форму, зверніть увагу на речення до та після поданого речення.
3. Виключіть неправильні відповіді.
4. Перевірте себе.

I. Reading

The Amish

1. They live in small towns, also called settlements in 19 states in the USA, southern Canada and Central America. The name 'Amish' comes from Jacob Amman, a seventeenth-century bishop in Switzerland. Although the Amish originated in Europe, they emigrated to the USA in search of religious freedom. In America, no matter where they settled, they continued their traditional farm life and their religious customs.
2. Amish children are frequently educated at home or in traditional Amish one-room schools and they do not attend classes after the eighth grade. The Amish teach their young people how to be homemakers and farmers, carpenters, and tradesmen from a very early age. By the time an Amish girl is twelve years old, she knows how to cook a meal for a whole group of Amish workers, and a young man knows how to farm by the time he is a teenager. They work on their family's farm or business until they marry.

3. They dress in a simple way. Men and boys usually wear dark-colored suits, black socks and shoes and black hats. The women and girls never cut their hair and they do not wear jewelry.
4. Some people think that the Amish are strange because they do not use petrol or electricity which pollute the environment. They are against cars, tractors, radio, television and telephones. They believe they should keep our planet clean.
5. Choosing a wife or husband is the key decision in an Amish person's life. It is interesting that instead of a diamond or gold ring, a man gives his bride china or a clock before they get married. At the wedding ceremony, the bride wears a blue dress which is the most popular color choice. Finally, the wedding usually takes place in November or December, on a Tuesday or Thursday. It is a fascinating event.
6. They speak a dialect of German at home; they use 'standard' German at their church services; and they learn English at school. They speak English when they have to communicate with anyone who is not Amish.
